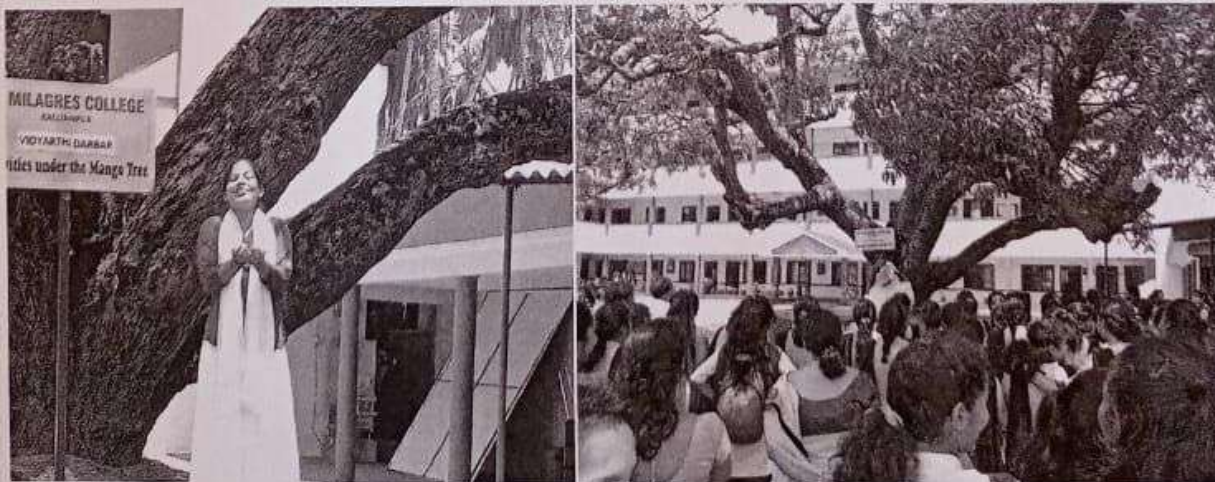


Vidhyarthi Darbar




