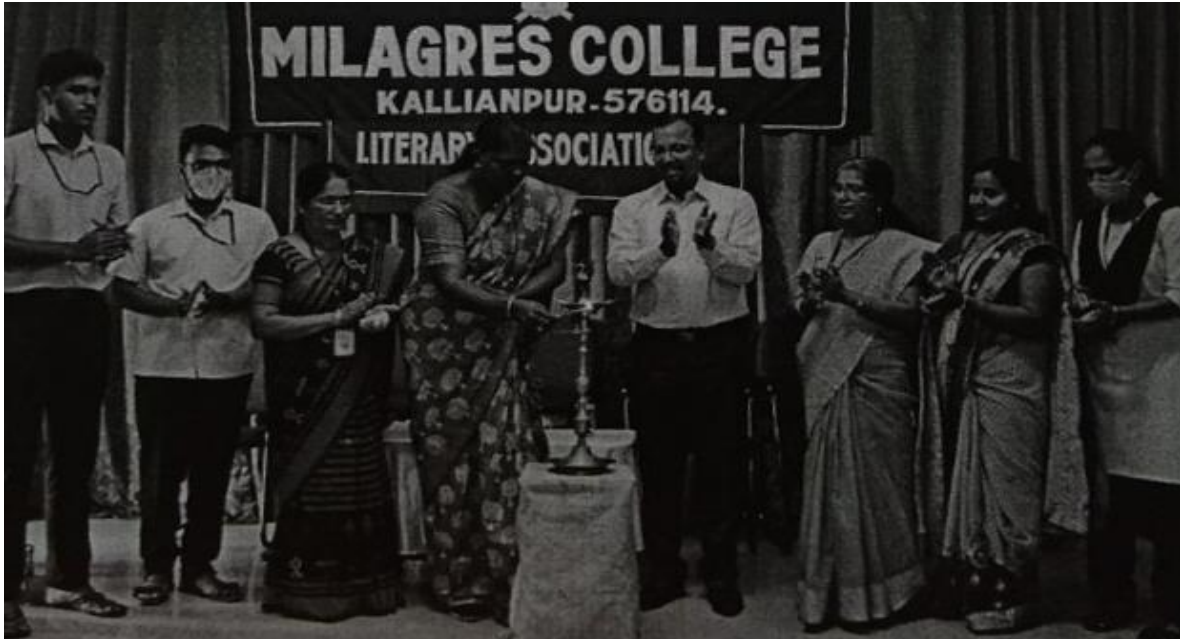


Literary Association 2020-2021
