We also met the caretaker. While interacting with the caretaker, we got to know the history of the orphanage how it was established.

On this occasion Our NCC cadets distributed stationery items, snacks, sports equipment for the children. The cadets interacted with the children. They also engaged them with various games and fun activities. All the children looked so excited and



joyful.

The team spent an about two hours with the children before bidding goodbye to them. It was indeed very satisfying experience for cadets, as they could bring smiles on children faces. They realized that one contribute and understand his /her social responsibilities towards society.
