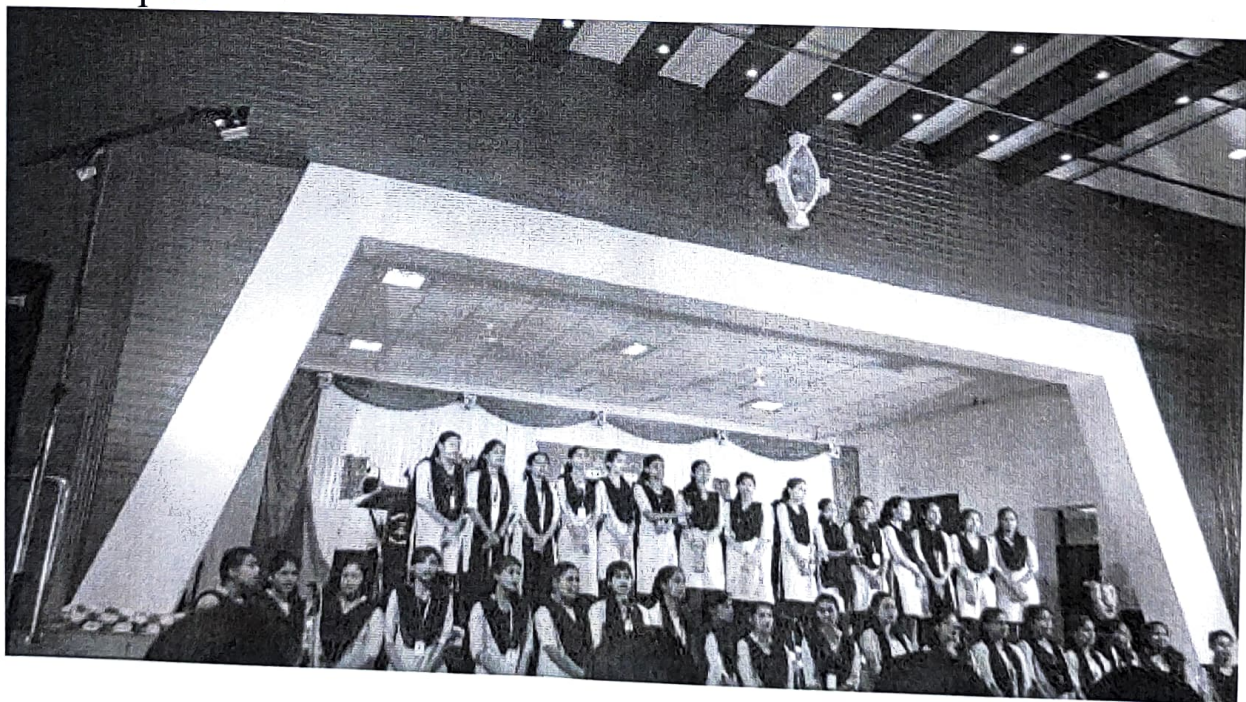

Milagres College, 'Students Welfare Council' inaugurated with all grace and dignity in the Tri-centenary Hall, Kallianpur.

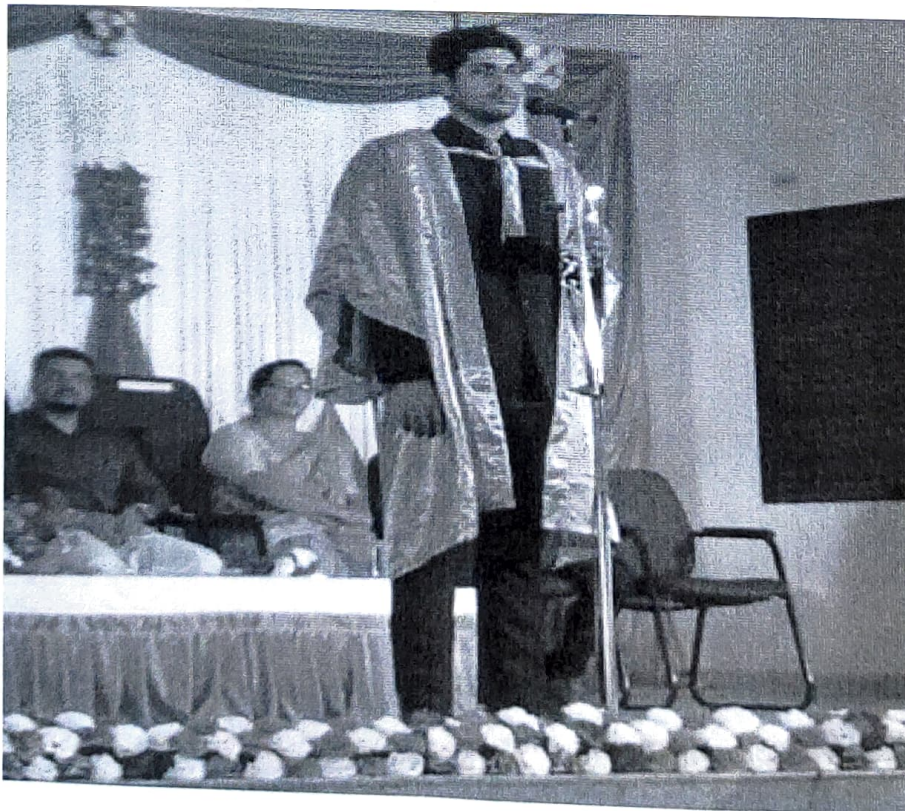

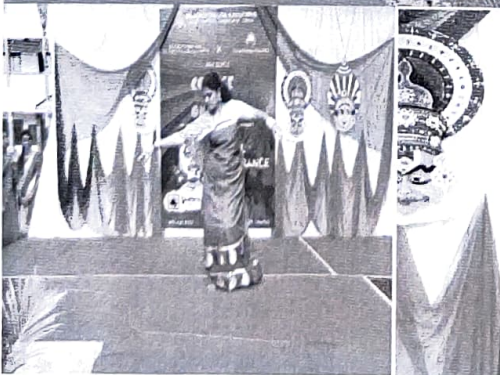

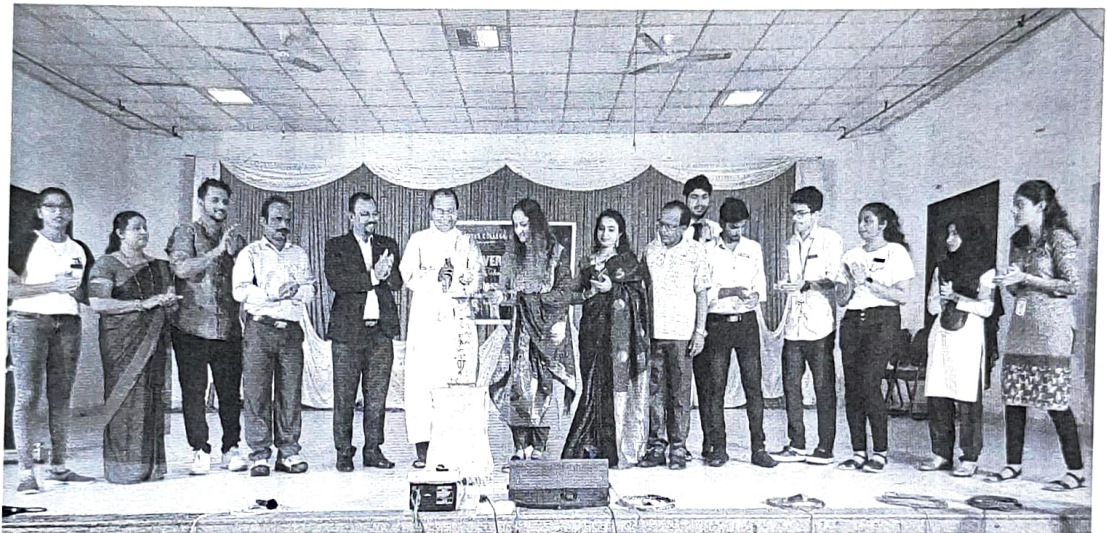
Milagres College celebrated Milaverse- 2022

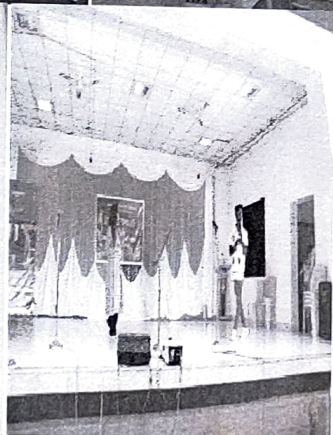
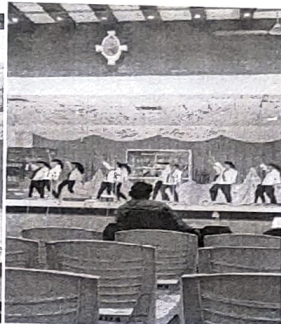
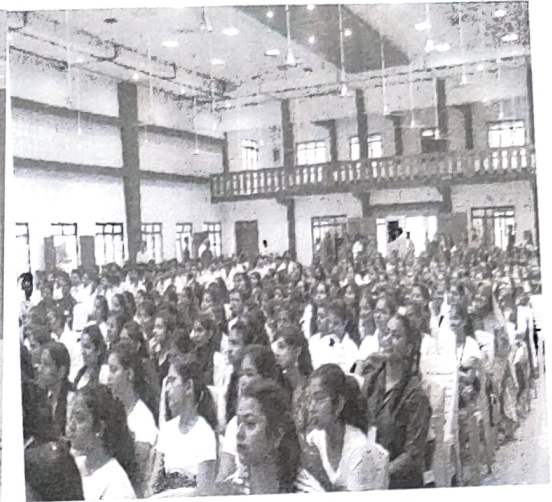

2nd Meeting

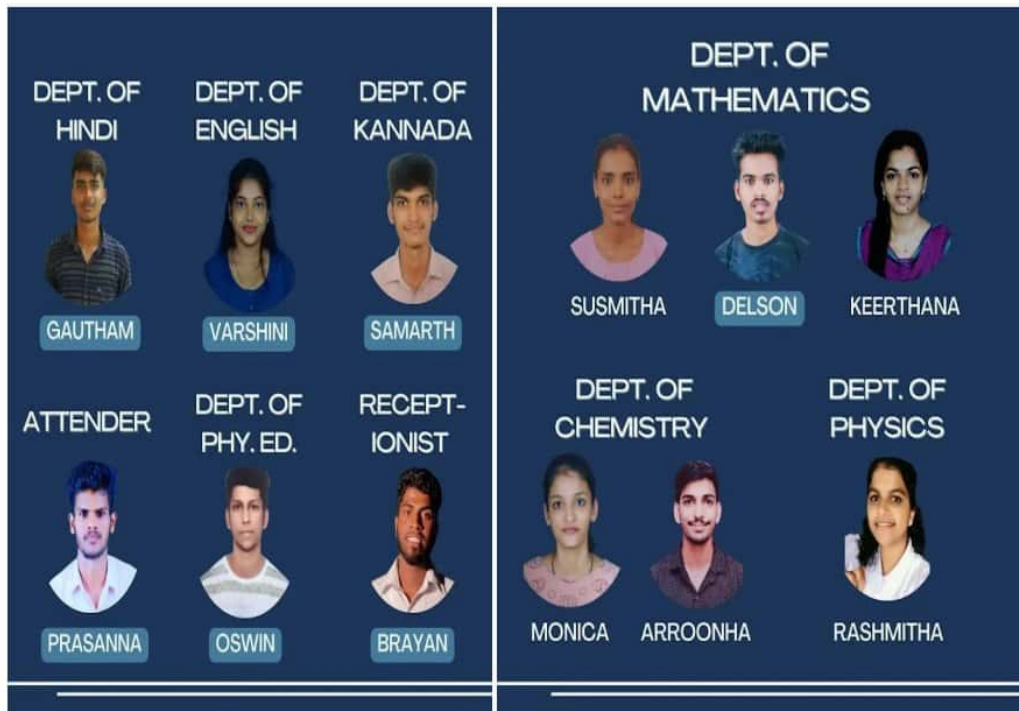
