## 1) GET TOGETHER PROGRAMME FOR BA STUDENTS

Department of English organised, "Fresher's Day" on 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2019 for the I BA students. Prof. Mary Mammen, retired HOD of English, Milagres College, was the chief guest. She gave a call to the students to utilise the library facility maximum. She said, "Develop your reading habit. It will lead you to the greatest height. In order to improve your vocabulary, you need to read, listen and communicate more". "Reading books broadens your knowledge and your knowledge leads you to achieve success", she added. The Principal, Dr. Vincent Alva in his speech said, "Start to communicate in broken English, gradually you will speak perfect English".

After the formal function, III BA students conducted ice- breaking session.



#### 2) CERTIFICATE COURSE IN COMMUNICATIVE ENGLISH

Department of English conducted a certificate course in 'Communicative English' for the period of 25 hours. Mr Jaikishan Bhat, Guest Lecturer of PG Departments of Poorna Prajna College, Udupi was the resource person for the course. Basic Principals of communication, types and channels of communication, reading skills for effective communication, employment communication, interviews, soft skills, group discussions, etc were the topics

covered during the course. 72 students from different courses enrolled their names for the same.

On 20/02/2020, the Department organised certificate distribution ceremony under the Mango tree. Mr Jaikishan Bhat expressed his gratitude towards the students and appreciated their active participation. Some of the beneficiaries of the course shared their feelings about their experiences.



#### 3) NATURE CAMP- A VISIT TO KEMTHUR VILLAGE, UDYAVAR

On 29/02/2020, all the BA students took part in the 'Nature Visit' organized by the Department of English. The venue selected for the camp was, Kemthur village, near Udyavar. The students had an exposure amidst the Banyan Trees, riverside, Kemthur Damn, hanging bridge and took pleasure in the beauty of nature. Some activity based games were conducted on the riverside. Later the students were divided in 6 groups and were asked to write a poem and sing with music. Within half an hour 11 poems were produced by our students with beautiful lyrics and tune, not only in English language but also in Kannada, Hindi and Tulu. Followed by lunch the outing was concluded with an evaluation where the students expressed their gratitude towards the Department for organizing such a wonderful camp and gave few suggestions for the further improvement.



## 4) OUTREACH TEACHING PROGRAMME

The Department had conducted outreach program- Teaching to the students of St Joseph Kannada Medium Primary School. 27 students of all the streams actively involved in organising the program. They took 20 hours of classes for 1-4 standard students. They prepared the syllabus under the guidance of Mrs Chandrika from the Department of English. The students conducted activity based classes for the children. The Headmaster of the school Mr Herald D'Silva praised our students for their active involvement in this program.





# 5) GUEST LECTURE ON 'AN ANALYSIS ON THE POETRY OF ROBERT FROST'

The Department organised a guest lecture on 'An analysis on the poetry of Robert Frost' for the students of III BA and I BSc, on 02-03-2020. Prof Cyril Mathias, retired HOD of English, Milagres College, Kallianpur, was the chief guest. He critically analysed the poems such as 'Mending Wall' and 'Stopping by the Woods on a Snowy Evening'. The students were also given guidance on the way in which they have to critically analyse the poems.

The program under the Mango tree is a mixture of both intellectual and fun filled activities.
