**Activities of 2020-21**

**1. An interactive session on ‘Sexual Harassment’**

On 25<sup>th</sup> of November 2020, Sexual Harassment Prevention cell organized a session on the topic “Problems and Queries related to Sexual harassment on women and girls” by Mrs. Muktha Shenoy, Asst Sub Inspector, Kota police station through google meet platform. This program was unfurled by Inchara of III BCom with her welcome speech. The principal of the college, Dr. Vincent Alva, Convenor of the cell Mrs. Radhika Patkar, committee members including teaching and non-teaching staff, leaders of SHP Cell, Student representatives, were the witnesses to this program.



## **2. Prevention of Cyber Offences**

The sexual harassment prevention cell of our college conducted an awareness programme on prevention of cyber offences for all the women students on 15-12-2020 at the A.V. hall. Shri..Ramachandra Nayak, Inspector, CEN police Station Udupi delivered an awareness lecture on cybercrimes like, fake web site, cyber bank fraud, how to be careful and precautions to be taken during online shopping, use of ATM. Dr. Vincent Alva, Principal Milagres College was the President of the Programme. Dr. Jayram Shettigar IQAC coordinator, Mrs. Radhika Patkar, the convenor of sexual harassment prevention cell, Mrs. Anupama NSS co-ordinator were present. ### **3. An Interactive session on ‘Physical and Mental Issues in Adolescent’**

On 10<sup>th</sup> of March, 2021, Sexual Harassment Prevention cell organized a session on the topic ‘Physical and Mental health issues in Adolescence’ by Dr. Rajalakshmi, Obstetrician & Gynaecologist, Santhekatte, Kallianpur. This program was unfurled by Nishmitha of III BCA with her welcome speech. The principal of the college, Dr. Vincent Alva, Convenor of the cell Mrs. Radhika Patkar, committee members

including teaching and non-teaching staff, leaders of SHP Cell, Student representatives, were the witnesses to this program.

The main aim of this program is to educate the girls about the problems and psychological effects during menstrual cycle. Dr Rajalaxmi addressed the students about the same. She explained about the changes that takes place during the puberty and the best age to attain puberty and also about the changes that takes place in boys after certain age, such as change in voice, muscle growth, growing of beards etc. She said about the psychological problems faces by the girls during their menstrual cycle and how to tackle them and also said about the normal and abnormal problems faced by them and she educated us on PCOS (polycystic ovary syndrome) which means irregular periods, excessive weight gain etc. She also spoke about AIDS and how the virus (HIV) can be transmitted or how it can enter a human body. She displayed various slides on them. She also gave information about the cancer vaccine for young girls. QHPV vaccine to fight against virus called human papilloma virus. And also spoke about the physical and mental health and also about how some girls suffer from Anaemia (loss of blood) she concluded it by saying everyone to maintain a healthy diet and eat healthy food.

At the end of the program, there was an interacting session where students asked questions and clarified their doubts regarding above given topic and Dr. Rajalakshmi, explained to them. Afterwards, vote of thanks was proposed by Varshini of III BSc.



#### **4. Interactive session on “effect of Covid-19 on teenage girls”:**

On 3<sup>rd</sup> September, 2021, Prevention of Sexual Harassment Cell (POSH) organized a session on the topic “Effects of Covid -19 on teenagers”. The resource person of the program was Dr. Maria Pais, Associate Professor, College of Nursing, MAHE Manipal.

The main aim of this program is to create awareness on negative effect of covid -19 on physical and mental health during pandemic and to educate students on Sexual exploitation and abuse.

Dr. Maria Pais addressed the students about the same. She said the pandemic’s economic impacts are likely to increase sexual exploitation and child marriage, leaving women and girls in fragile economies and refugee contexts particularly vulnerable. She also explained how we can protect ourselves in the society during

this pandemic. She gave some tips to the students. She presented videos n explained the practical situations with live examples. It was very effective and informative session to the students.

Principal of the College, was the president of the program, Dr. Jayaram Shettigar IQAC Coordinator, Mrs. Radhika Patkar Convenor of POSH Cell, Mrs Reshma, Convenor of Women Cell were present. ## 5. Interactive session with Ms. Mamtaz, District Judge

September 06, Kallianpur: Prevention of Sexual Harassment Cell in association with Vidyarthi Darbar of the college witnessed a memorable interactive session with Mamtaz newly nominated District Judge.



Ms Mamtaz is from Mulki of Dakshina Kannada District who is the daughter of Atijamma and Abdul Rehiman. She pursued her Primary and High School education in Bharatmata School at Punaroor near Mulki and Pre-University course at Pompai College, Kirem near Kinnigoli and LLB at SDM Law College at Mangaluru. Meanwhile she had done her post- graduation at Mysuru Open University. In the examination of Judges held at February / March 2021, Mumtaz secured first rank among 12 people in the state who got selected being first Muslim woman as a District judge in the state.



“Other than becoming a lawyer, law graduates are desirable candidates for various fields such as media and law, academia, commerce and industry, social work, politics and more. You will find that studying law can take you just about anywhere.” she said while answering to the question raised by the audience. Mumtaz has enlightened the students of the College by sharing her own life stories with incidence which she experienced in her life. “We have to give up our sleep in order to achieve some goals in our life” she added.
