PREVENTION OF CYBER OFFENCES: The women cell conducted an awareness programme on prevention of cyber offences for all the women students on 15-12-2020. Shri. Ramachandra Nayak, Inspector, CEN police Station Udupi delivered an awareness lecture on cybercrimes like, fake web site, cyber bank fraud, how to be careful and precautions to be taken during online shopping, use of ATM. Dr. Maria Pais explained about the negative effects of covid 19 on teenagers. It's impact on mental health and how we can avoid the adverse effect on our lives. 



The library has a wide repository of books, journals, CDs, newspapers, rare books, e-resources, previous years' question papers etc. National and international journals on most of the subjects taught in the College are made available to the students. Newspaper clippings provides information regarding the various activities in the college. The library has books and journals related to career guidance and competitive examinations which helps students to face various competitive examinations with confidence. College Library has 41489 books 96 Textual CD's worth 31,45,789.00. We have subscribing 12 Newspapers and 86 periodicals. During the current academic year, 434 books worth Rs.88,504.00 were added to the library. The library is computerised with Easylib Library Management Software. Easylib In-Out management software is used for automated Attendance monitoring for capturing the footfall in the library. The library has a good collection of rare books. Apart from the Central Library, each department has a departmental library and books are issued to students from both the central and departmental libraries. We have a separate PG library

E- RESOURCE: The academic year 2020-21 was a highly challenging year due to the lockdown the focus was on the usage of e-resources and the major challenge was to convincing students to make maximum usage of e-resources. For that our college library is registered with the N-List Programme of INFLIBNET Centre funded by the Ministry of Human Resources Development, under its National Mission on Education through ICT and subscribe E-Resources (6,150 electronic journals and 31,64,309 electronic books) for the benefit of its users. To make the best use of these e-resources, user ID and password has been created and given for both students and staff.
































DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS (BCA)
