### **INAUGURAL PROGRAMME (05/02/2017):**

The inauguration of “Tribal Exposure Camp” was held at Govt. Primary School, Kaigadi at 5.30pm. Mr. Ganesh Vadda Kunubi, President, School Development and Management Committee, Government Primary School, Kaigadi had presided the inaugural programme. Mrs. Shanthi Siddhi, senior member of Siddhi Community of Kaigadi, inaugurated the camp by lighting the lamp. Key note address given by the Coordinator of Camp Mr. Vignesh. Mrs. Mohini S Poojary, Managing Trustee, TEED Trust, Yalapuraal was the chief guest of the inaugural programme Mr. Mukund and Mr. Devraj, associates of TEED Trust were also present in the programme. There were around 50 villagers attended the inaugural programme.





### **SOCIO-ECONOMIC SURVEY (06/02/2017):**

socio-economic survey was conducted to understand the social and economic conditions of Kunubi and Siddi tribal groups of Kaigadi Village. Through survey, the campers collected information about traditional occupation, sources of income, social strata, family structure, religious practices, traditional dance forms, benefits from various Governmental and Non-Governmental organization, status of education, problems of the community etc. Post Lunch the survey findings on both Kunubi and Siddhi tribals were analyzed by the campers in different teams by preparing the activity charts.

### **PARTICIPATORY RURAL APPRAISAL (PRA) (07/02/2017):**

Participatory rural appraisal (PRA) was conducted at Govt. Primary School, Kaigadu by the campers to assess the conditions of the village. The students had involved the villagers namely, Mrs. Laxmi Siddhi, Mrs. Shanthi Siddhi, Mrs. Renuka Kunubi, Mr. Ganesh Vadda Kunubi and Mr. Damodar in order to do the **Social Mapping, Venn Diagram, Resource in flow and out flow charts and Seasonal Diagram**. These activities were distributed to the

groups and each group involved sufficient number of villagers in order to provide the information of their village.

This participatory activity gave the campers an insight to the community need and available resources. Further, they could build the bridge between the facts found out in the social survey and the outcome of PRA.

### **TRAINING ON PUGUDI AND TALAGADI TRADITIONAL DANCE FORMS OF SIDDHI AND KUNUBI COMMUNITY (09/02/2017):**

The campers had a task of learning traditional dance forms of Siddhi and Kunubi tribal groups namely Pugudi and Talagadi in teams with the guidance of the villagers. Half of the students were involved in Pugudi dance and team of women (Ms.Laxmi Siddhi, Ms.Shanthi Siddhi and others) of Siddhi community helped the students to learn the songs and the dance. The rest of the team was trained on Talagadi dance by Mr. Ganesh Vadda Kunubi and mr. Krishna Vadda Kunubi. Later in the Valedictory Programme students had performed it to the villagers.

**Day 1:**

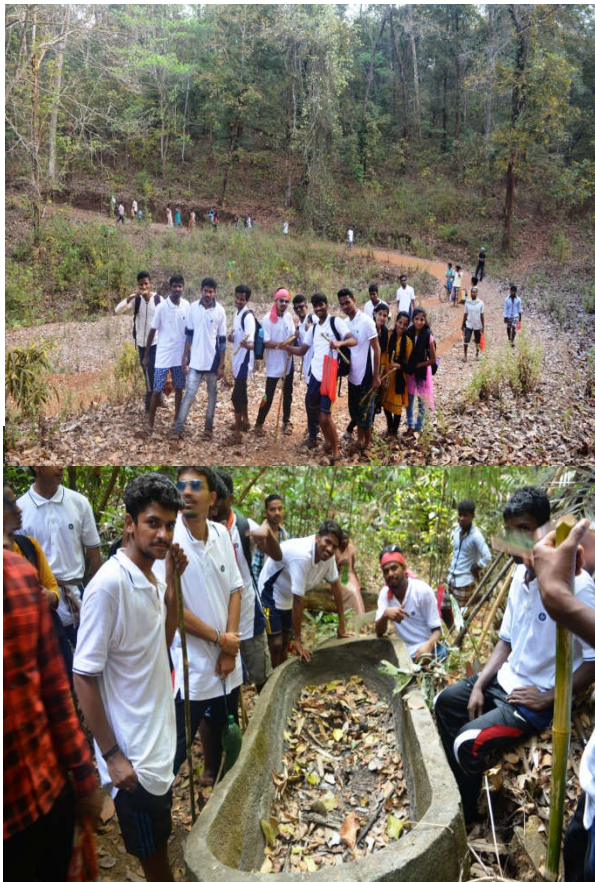

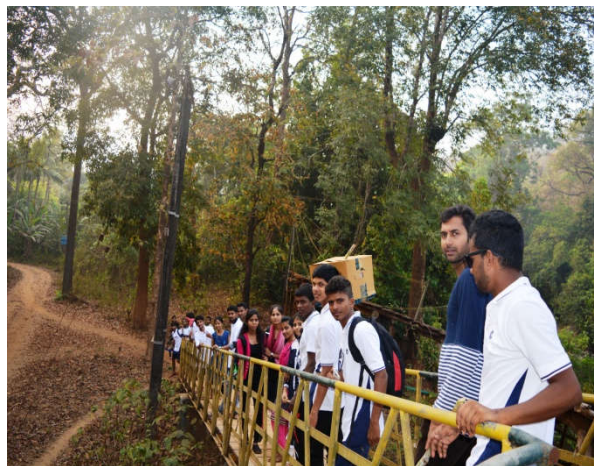
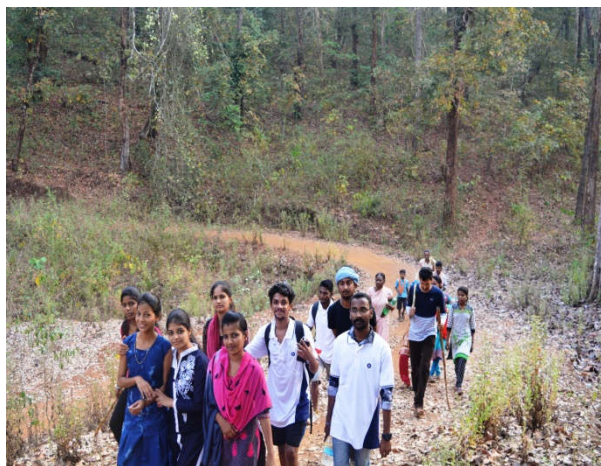

Key note address was given by Camp Co-ordinator Mrs. Reshma. Ms. Asha, staff of CORD also present in the programme. Around 20 villagers attended the inaugural programme along with the MSW students.



### **Socio-economic survey (17/2/2019)**

Socio-economic survey was conducted to understand the social, cultural and economical conditions of Soliga and Marati Naika groups of Avaregunda. Through Survey, the campers collected information about traditional occupation, traditional food, traditional dance form, family structure, sources of income, religious practice, benefits from various Government and Non-Governmental Organisation, educational status, problem of the community, need of the community etc. Post lunch, the survey on Soliga, Jenu Kuruba and Marati Naika Tribals were analysed by the campers in different teams and had graphical presentation.



In evening around 6.45pm onwards for about 2 hours, campers gave awareness and cultural programme to the villagers.

### **Agricultural work and PRA (18/2/2019)**

All the campers did agricultural work in Mr. Vasu Naik's garden. Campers carried fertilizer to the garden and also collected dry wood for cooking and water was taken away from well.

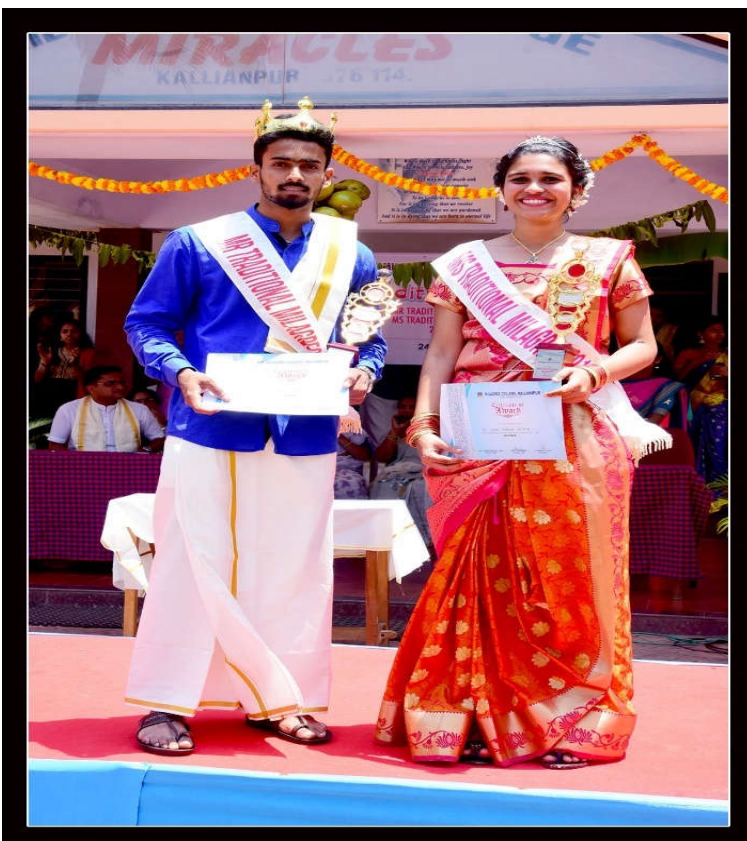
### Talents' day 2017
