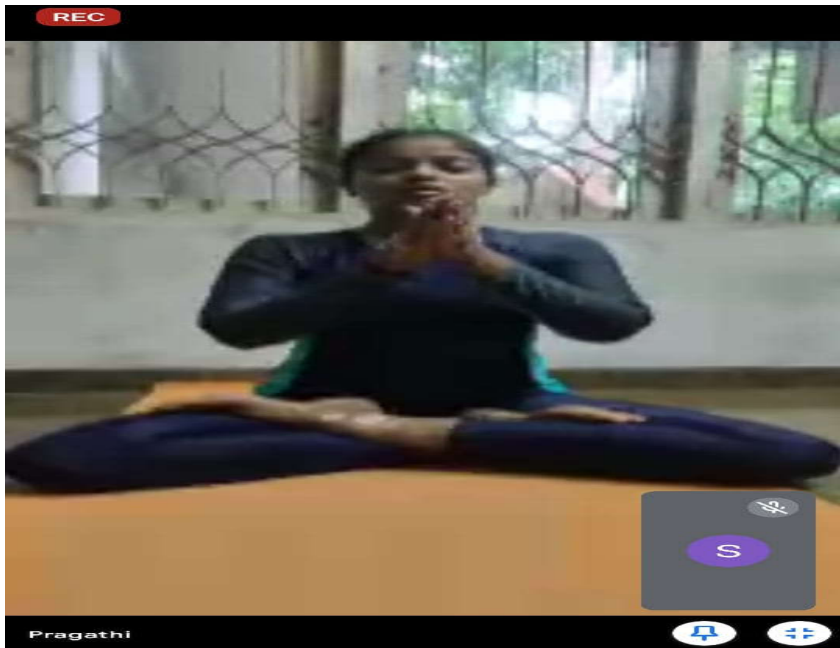
WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 05.0.2021
