On 21-7-2018.KattaleBasadi is a small campus with two Jain Basadis, now in abandoned status. KattaleBasadi is located in Barkur town, about 5 kms from Brahmavara and 20 kms from Udupi in Karnataka.Kattale refers to Dark.

The Basadi is called KattaleBasadi because of unique design. The Basadis are totally covered with stone walls and roof on all side, except one tiny entrance, only source of light. The entrance faces south and has some carvings to its side. One can take a look inside



the basadi from outside. There are no deities inside at present and no pooja is performed. Kattalebasadi complex has 3 temples and some more ruins. One temple is dedicated to Jain Thirthankara while other two were meant for Shiva and Vishnu. Temple structures measure about 30-35 ft in length and 20-22 feet in width.
