

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**7. COTPA**: The Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003 or COTPA, 2003 is an Act of Parliament of India enacted in 2003 to prohibit advertisement of, and to provide for the regulation of trade and commerce in, and production, supply and distribution of cigarettes and other tobacco products in India. This Act was enacted by the Parliament to give effect to the Resolution passed by the 39th World Health Assembly, urging the member states to implement measures to provide non-smokers protection from involuntary exposure to tobacco smoke.

IQAC has organised an awareness programm on COTPA on 20<sup>th</sup> Feb 2018 in the AV Hall. Principal Dr. Vincent Alva presided over the programme. Udupi District HealthEducation Officer Smt. Arathi made a presentation on the impact of the use of tobacco. Miss.Social Activist made a presentation on COTPA and its provisions. 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

(NAAC) has continuously strived to improve its methodology Takingcognizance of changing trends in higher education and aligning the reforms and rapidly transforming global education scenario, NAAC has embarked in revising the Assessment and Accreditation (A&A) methodology. The revised framework developed in partnership with stakeholders have a distinct focus on data capture for quantitative assessment and process details for qualitative assessment and is an effort to make the A&A process more robust , objective, transparent, outcome oriented and stake holder friendly.

NAAC has changed the evaluation method of educational institutions including recording the data of universities and colleges online. This will also reduce human interference in the assessment process of educational institutes. In the new system a major chunk of the data about an educational institute will be captured online, a team of assessors would still visit the institutions.

With a view to make the assessment and accreditation process more rigorous and its outcome more credible, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) will introduce a new methodology of assessment .The new methodology of Institutional Assessment and Accreditation of NAAC had been designed to overcome some of the limitations of its earlier methodology.
