#### **Selection Process**

The Committee constituted with The Principal, Convenor and the members is entrusted to select the deserving students to avail this facility.


Applications were invited from the students who wish to avail the facility. Committee formed for this purpose went through the applications and intimated the students to appear before the interview committee.

Students were selected on the basis of poverty, merit, distance from home to college, sports achievements, involvement in NCC etc.

Now 131 students are identified as the beneficiaries for the year 2021-22 out of which 115 students will be provided with Free Meals and another 16 will be provided with subsidized meals.
