
Academic Activities:

• Take the students to advance laboratories:

A visit to the Research Laboratories of the department of Physics, Microtron Centre at Mangalore University and to the 'Science Centre' at Pilikula was organised on 15th February 2017. Twenty-nine students of Final year B.Sc along with the staff members of the department of Physics of our college first visited the laboratories at Centre for Advanced Research in Environmental Radioactivity(CARER) and also at the Centre for Application of Radioisotopes and Radiation Technology (CARRT). Students were exposed to various methods of sample processing, isotope separation, Radon calibration, Gamma spectrometry etc at

CARER. They were given information regarding Gamma Irradiation Chamber used for various applications,urea breath test using C¹⁴ Analyzer, TLC scanners etc at CARRT.

The students were then taken to MICROTRON Centre. The faculty there explained the working of the particle accelerator.

The group also visited the 'Science Centre' at Pilikula after lunch. The students had hand on experience with the science models explaining fundamental principles of science. Also 3D film was viewed by the group.
