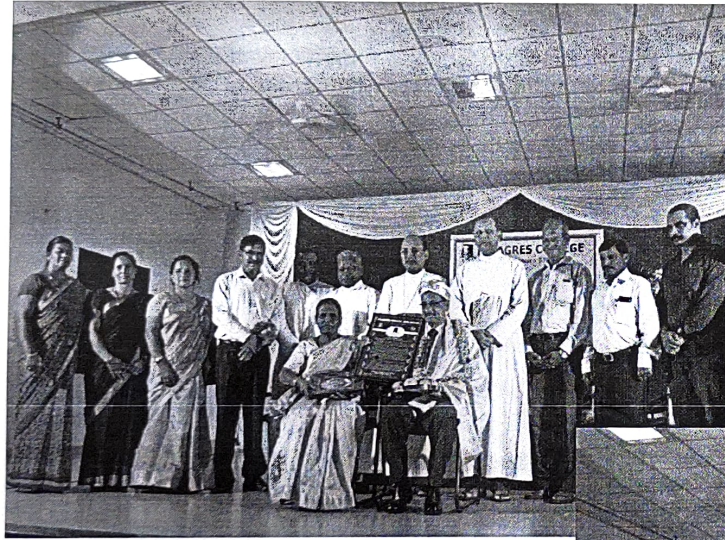

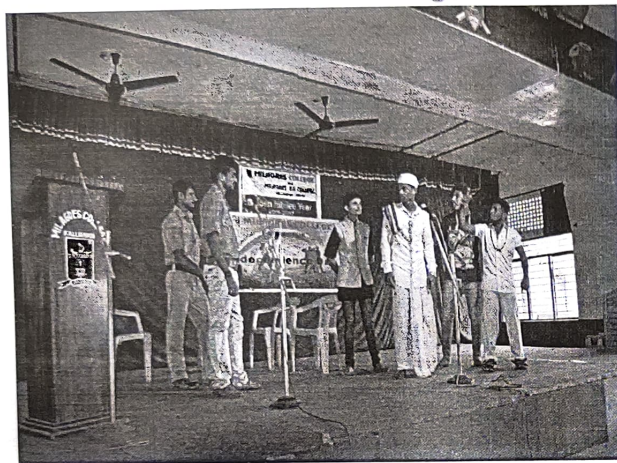


INDEPENDENCE DAY

After the flag hoisting, in association with N.S.S Unit of the College, the Students' Welfare Council members performed cultural programmes like patriotic songs, skits, etc



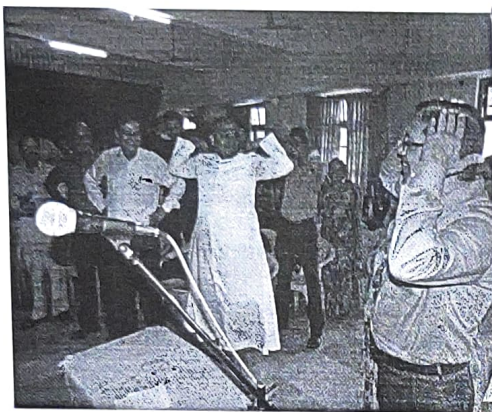


TALENTS DAY

Teachers Day was celebrated on 7th September 2016. Various games were conducted for the teachers and all teachers took part very actively and enthusiastically in them.





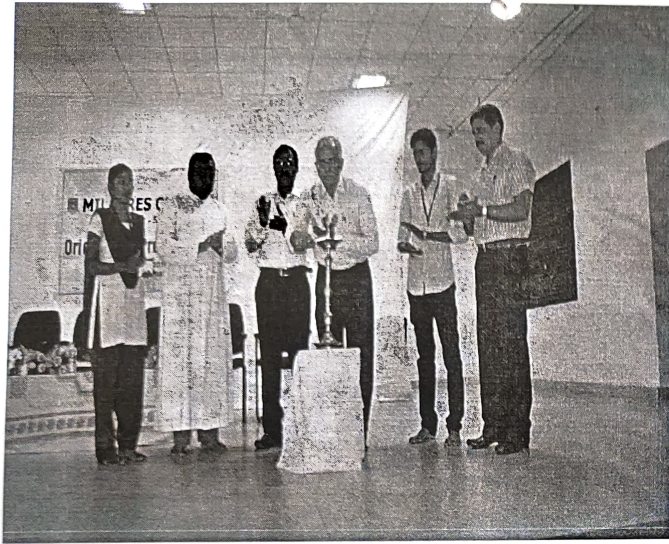

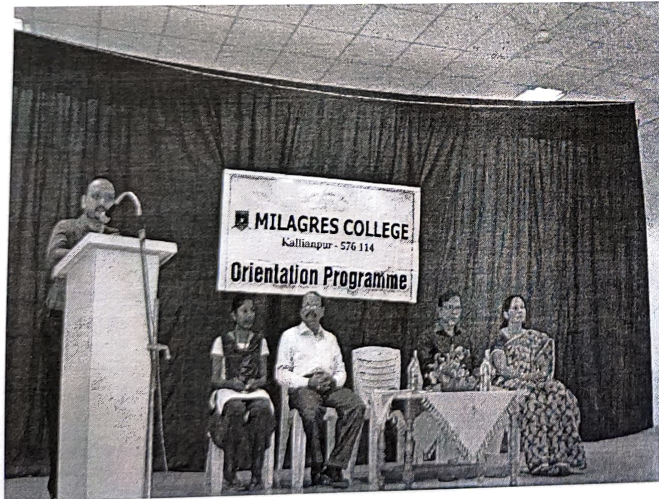


Value Education

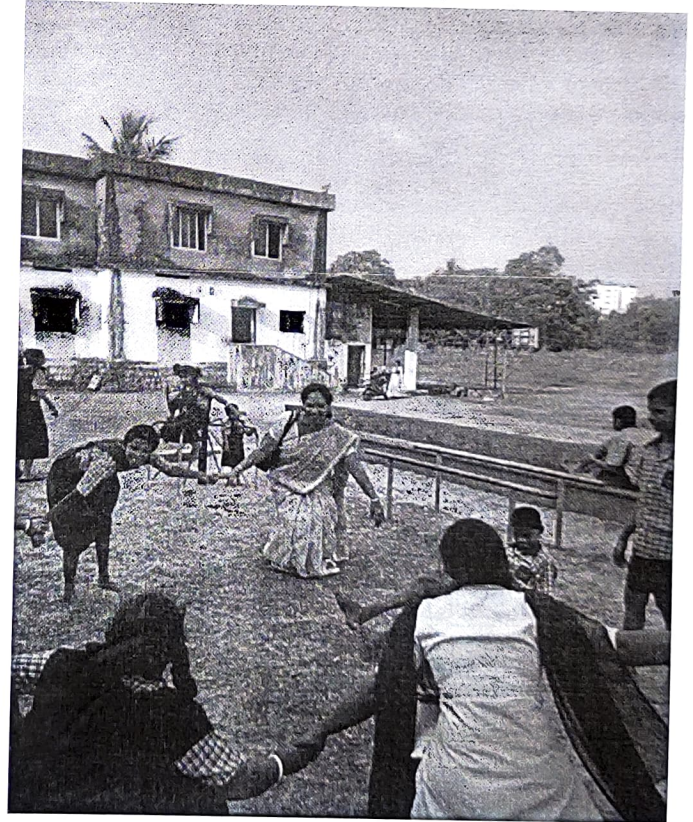


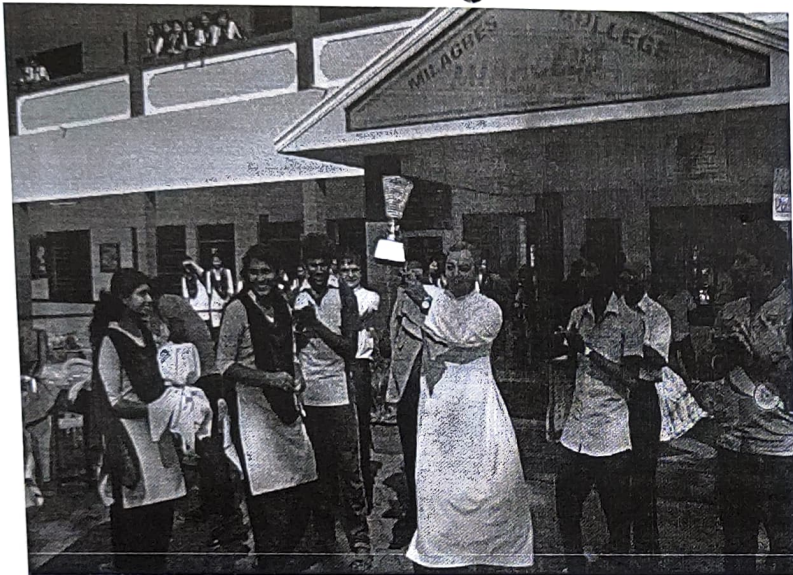


Charity Visit

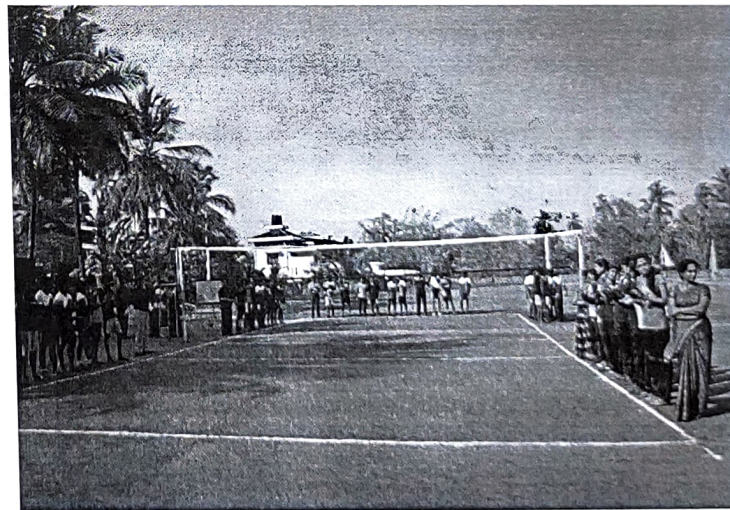

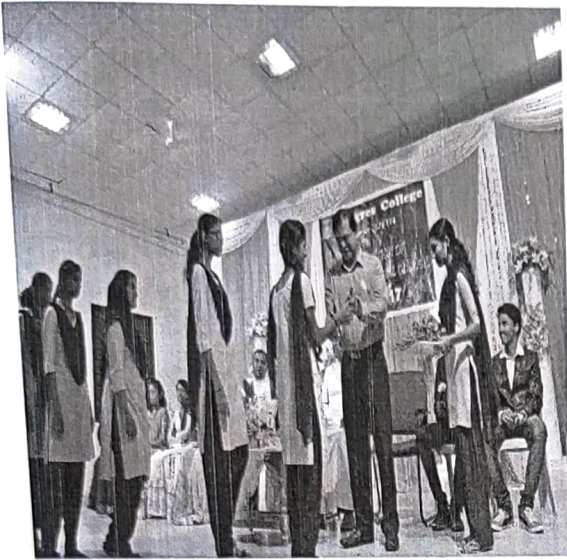
Students Welfare Council 2015-16 Inauguration

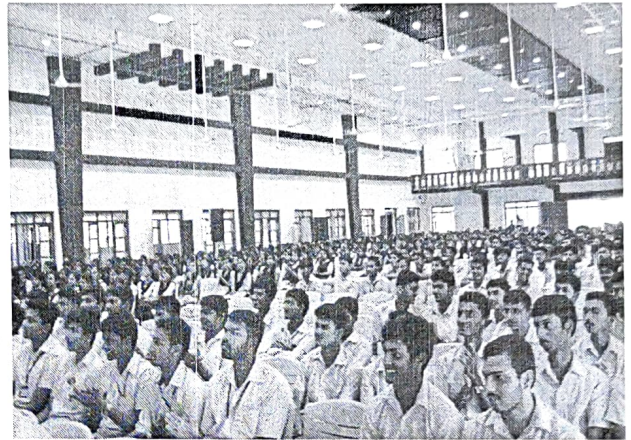

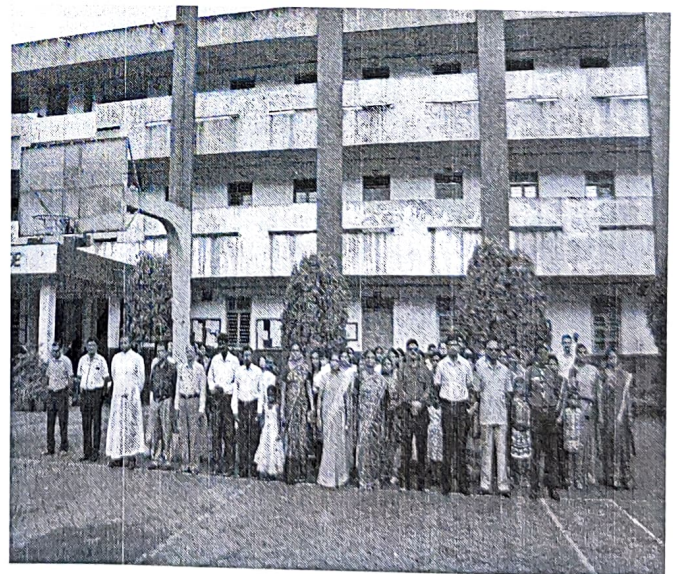
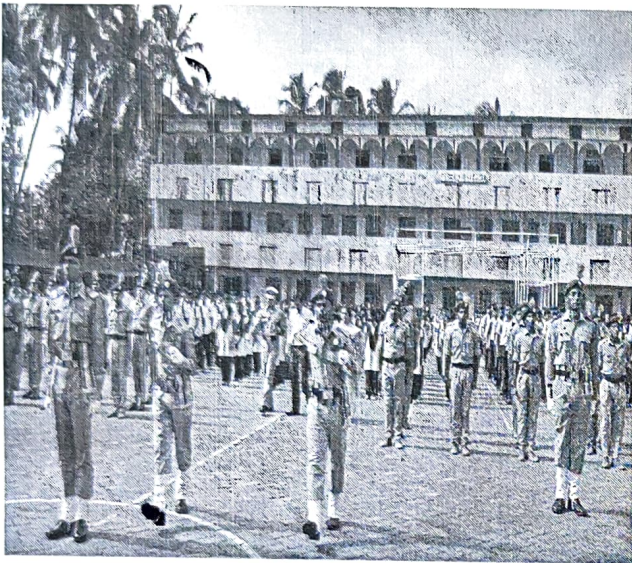


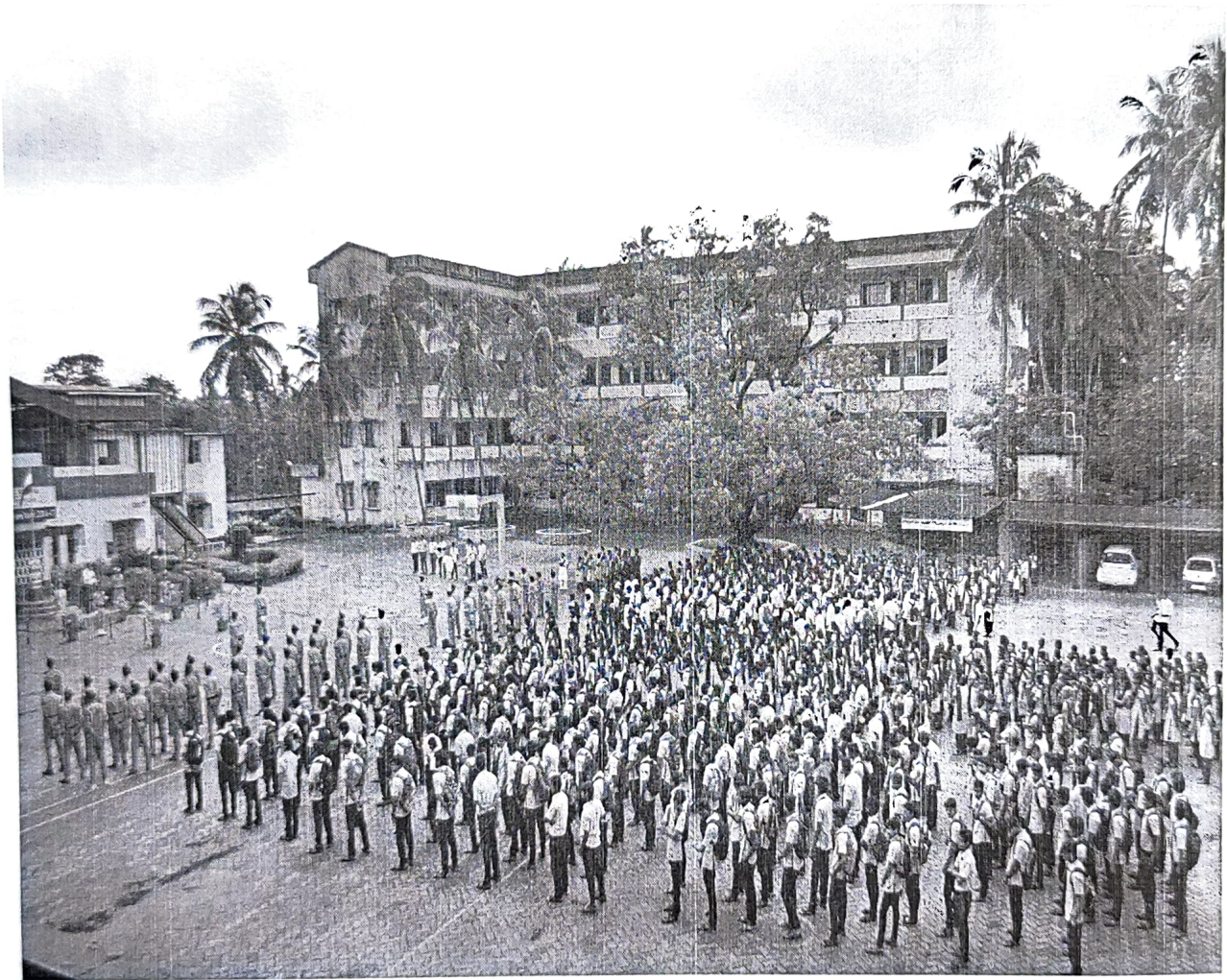




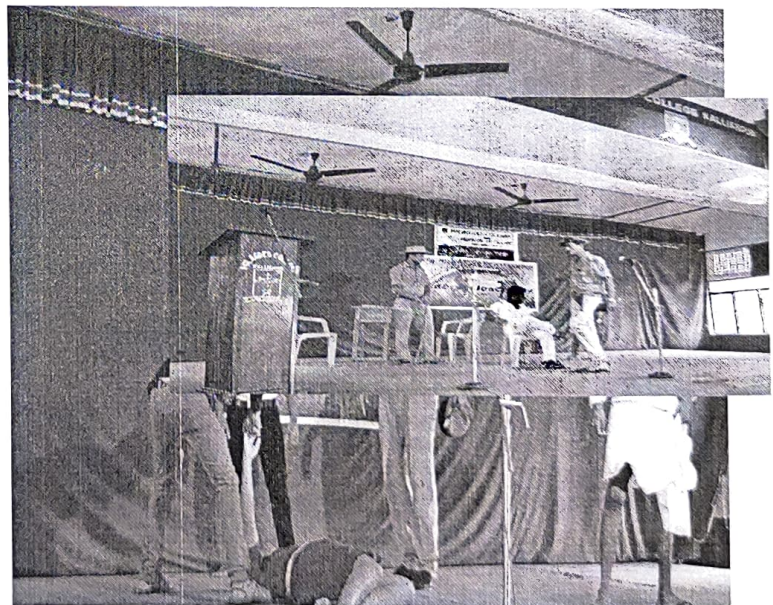
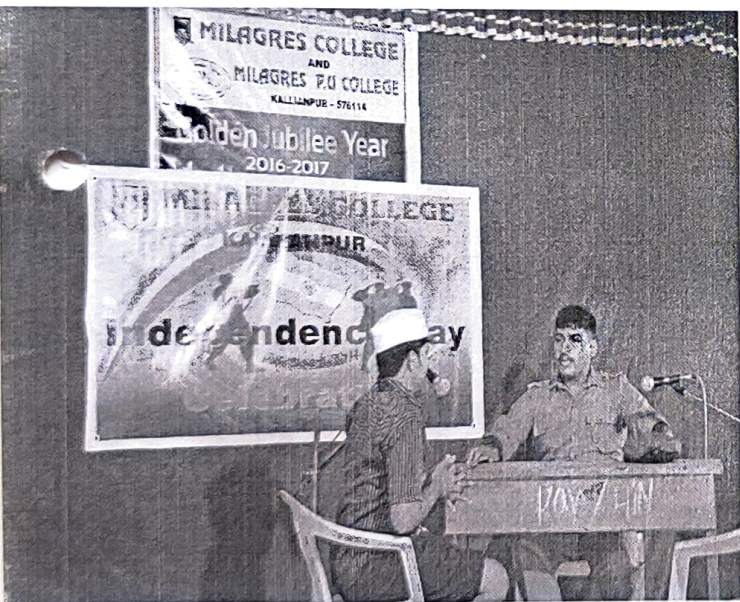
INDEPENDENCE DAY

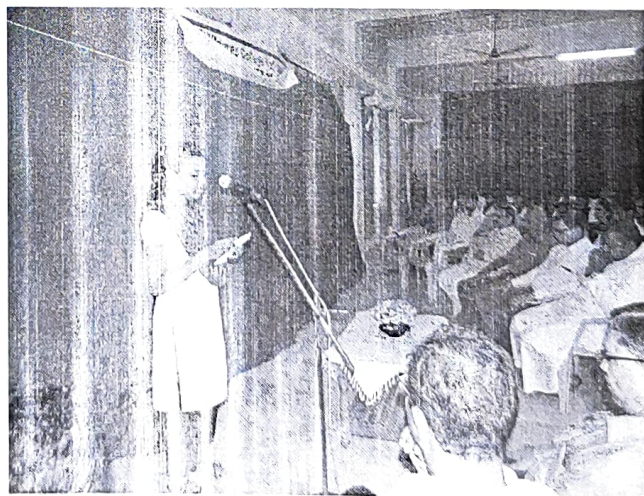


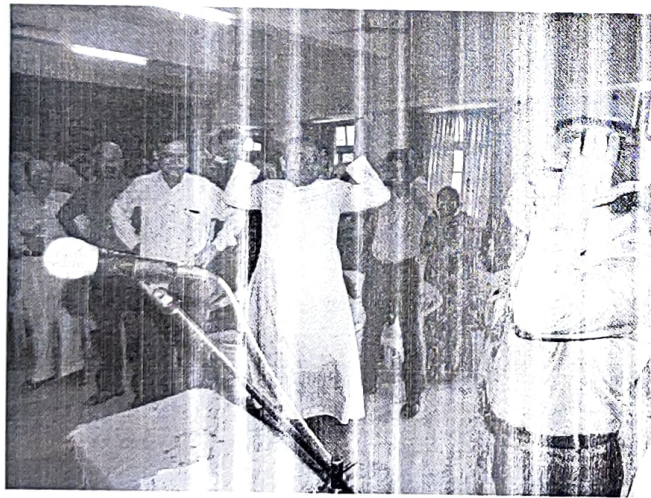
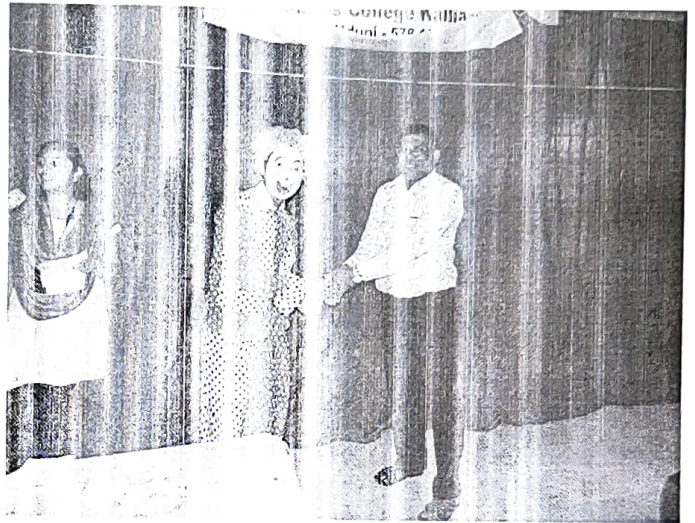


Teachers Day Celebrations
