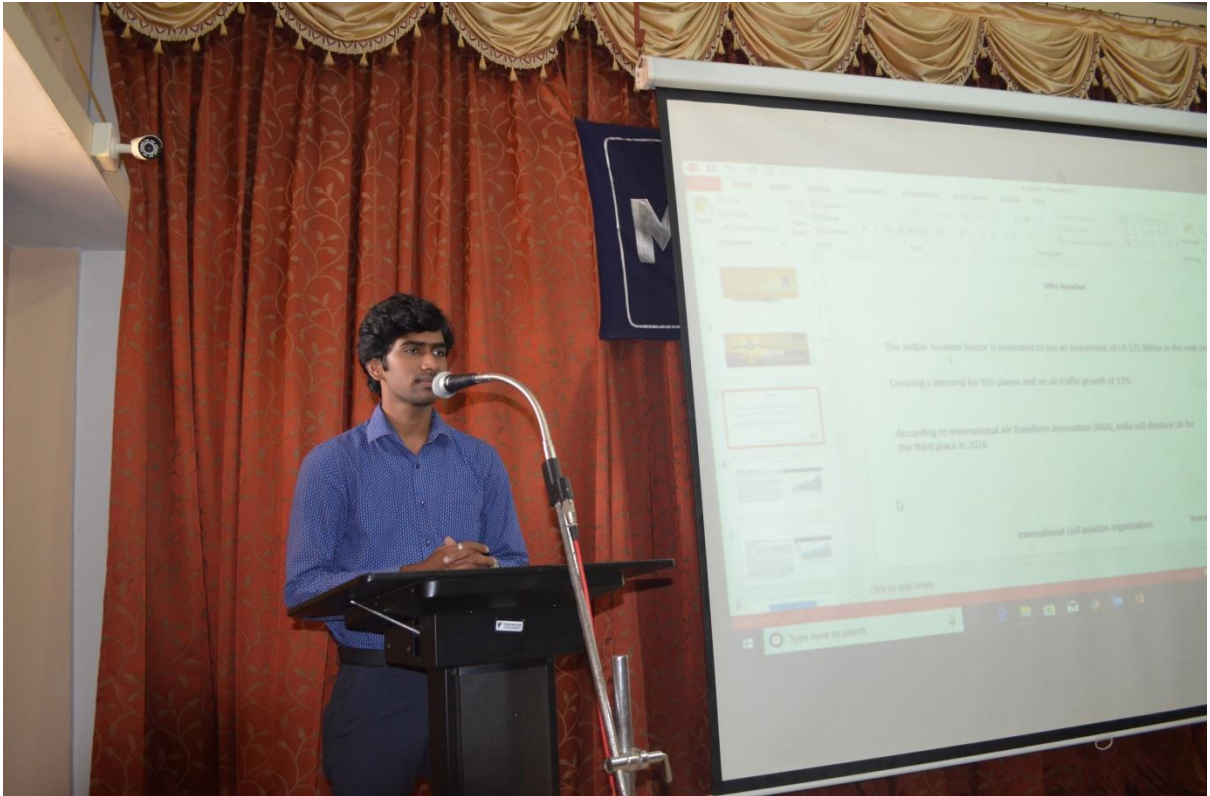
j) On 'Life and requirements of Corporate World'

n) Food fest

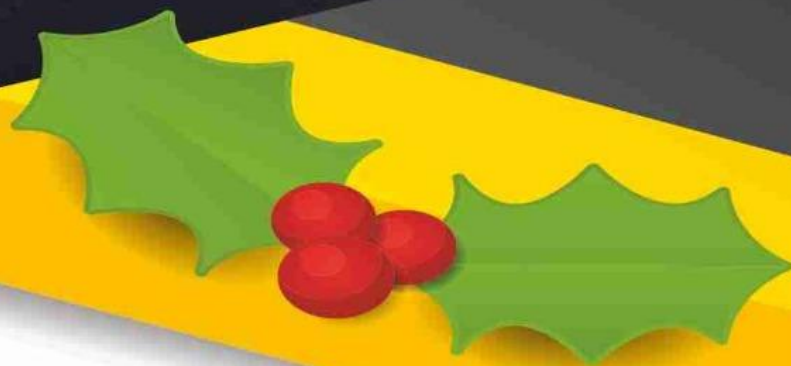
