3. IQAC has organised Jala Shakti Mission Programme on 16-11-2021 in association with Zilla Panchayat Water Board Udipi District. Principal incharge Prof Sophia Dias preside over the programme. Inspired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister's impetus on Jal Sanchay, the Jal Shakti Abhiyan (JSA) is a time-bound, mission-mode water conservation campaign. The JSA will run in two Phases: Phase 1 from 1st July to 15th September 2019 for all States and Union Territories; and Phase 2 from 1st October to 30th November 2019 for States and UTs receiving the retreating monsoon (Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Puducherry and Tamil Nadu). During the campaign, officers, groundwater experts and scientists from the Government of India will work together with state and district officials in India's most water-stressed districts for water conservation and water resource management by focusing on accelerated implementation of five target intervention. The JSA aims at making water conservation a Jan Andolan through asset creation and extensive communication.



4. Martyrs Day: 30 January is the date observed in the national level as Martyrs Day. The date was chosen as it marks the assassination of Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi in 1948, by Nathuram Godse. IQAC has organised a programme and paid tribute to the Father of Nation on Martyrs Day. Dr Jayaram Shettigar HOD History delivered a special lecture on the contribution of Gandhi. Principal Dr Vincent Alva, Staff and Students haave participated in the programme.

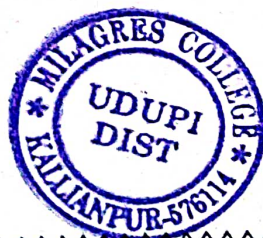
