and think-tank and mischief spot too for the students. To give a distinct and productive shape to these activities the concept called "Under the Mango Tree" was born.

**VALUE EDUCATION**

Value education is an integral part of the college. To help the students to become more and more responsible and sensible citizen, various activities have been organized in the college. The college through value education classes tries to inculcate right interests, attitudes and moral and intellectual values needed for the students which help them to attain their life goals.

**MID DAY MEAL SCHEME:**

Being incepted in the year 1996, the Midday Meal Scheme of our college is continuously helping the poor and needy students with Free Meals and Subsidized Meals. This noble project is sponsored by the generous donors, members of the staff, alumni and the PTA members.

This is one of the oldest best practices in the college. Realizing that many students come from far off places and not been able to afford for mid-day meal on their own, the college came up with this scheme through which the students are provided with free and subsidized meal for the afternoon.

The Committee constituted with The Principal, Convenor and the members is entrusted to select the deserving students to avail this facility. Students were selected on the basis of poverty, merit, distance from home to college, sports achievements, involvement in NCC etc.

The Mid day meal Scheme was launched in the year 1996-1997.Thanks to the generosity of the donors for their good- will towards the poor and needy students. It was started with a capital fund of Rs One Lakh invested in fixed deposit. Out of the interest accrued the Mid-day Meal, meals are being served to the needy students in the college canteen. Generous donors and teachers contribute towards the Mid-day meal scheme every year. The College remains ever grateful to all the donors. The scheme was started for the poor and needy students where in free meals were provided for these students. When the number of student applicants increased for this Scheme it was decided to provide subsidized meals to the students in addition to free meals for the poor and needy students on the basis of merit. This year 110 students and 60 stu-

dents were the beneficiaries of free and subsidised mid day meal respectively.

#### **FREE EMERGENCY MEDICAL FACILITY FOR THE STUDENTS**

Milagres College has a Memorandum of Understanding with Goretti Hospital, Santhekatte for meeting the emergency medical needs of the students. When a situation arises, the student is immediately rushed to Goretti Hospital wherein emergency medical treatment is provided.

#### **FEE CONCESSIONS FOR THE STUDENTS**

Milagres College is situated in the Rural Area and the students come from poor and backward families. Many of the students are in need of financial assistance for continuing their education, especially women students. It is here where Milagres College provides a helping hand for these students. The Management has been generous enough to offer fee concession for the poor and deserving students.

#### **FINANCIAL AID/ASSISTANCE TO THE STUDENTS**

Financial aid/assistance to the students is offered through the philanthropic persons from their donations. The PTA, Alumni Association and other well-wishers of the college have been kind enough to sponsor an amount of Rs.6,31,000 towards financial aid for our student's education.
