The Committee constituted with The Principal, Convenor and the members is entrusted to select the deserving students to avail this facility. Students were selected on the basis of poverty, merit, distance from home to college, sports achievements, molvement in NCC etc.

The Mid day meal Scheme was launched in the year 1996-1997. Thanks to the generositwof the donors for their good- will towards the poor and needy students. It was started with a capital fund of Rs One Lakh invested in fixed deposit. Out of the interest accrued the Mid-day Meal, meals are being served to the needy students in the college canteen. Generous donors and teachers contribute towards the Mid-day meal scheme every year. The College remains ever grateful to all the donors. The scheme was started for the poor and needy students where in free meals were provided for these students. When the number of student applicants increased for this Scheme it was decided to provide subsidized meals to the students in addition to free meals for the poor and needy students on the basis of merit. This year 110 students and 60 stu-

dents were the beneficiaries of free and subsidised mid day meal respectively.

### FREE EMERGENCY MEDICAL FACILITY FOR THE STUDENTS

Milagres College has a Memorandum of Understanding with Goretti Hospital, Santhekatte for meeting the emergency medical needs of the students. When a situation arises, the student is immediately rushed to Goretti Hospital wherein emergency medical treatment is provided.




